PRESS RELEASE

The Director General of Elections has the honour to inform the general public and stakeholders of the electoral process that the Elections Cameroon web portal is now effectively accessible through the address www.elecarn.cm. This portal grants access to the website and to an online verification of enrolment on electoral registers.

In this respect, a broad spectrum of information is posted on this website, notably:

- organisation of Elections Cameroon and its duties;
- current electoral news;
- updated statistics on the register of voters;
- electoral education and training;
- location of Elections Cameroon Branches (Regional Delegations, Divisional Branches, Council Branches) and that of Cameroonian diplomatic missions and consular posts abroad.

This verification of enrolment on electoral registers allows every elector to crosscheck only his/her enrolment, using either the enrolment number legible on their voter's card or their enrolment receipt, or even using their personal information (full name, date and place of birth, mother's name). The web portal also offers a possibility to lodge complaints relating to enrolment.

The Director General of Elections would like to point out that verification of enrolment on electoral registers can only be done on the register of voters that was cleaned up and published in December 2024. For that reason, he reminds the general public that the said register of voters contains 7 845 622 electors, which includes 7 818 822 at national level and 26 800 abroad. He further emphasises that information on the revision of electoral registers for the year 2025 will only be available on the web portal upon completion of the clean-up exercise that will begin once this revision comes to a close, after the convening of electors for the election of the President of the Republic.

The Director General of Elections is therefore calling on the public at large, stakeholders of the electoral process and any interested party to visit this platform and obtain reliable electoral information.
